

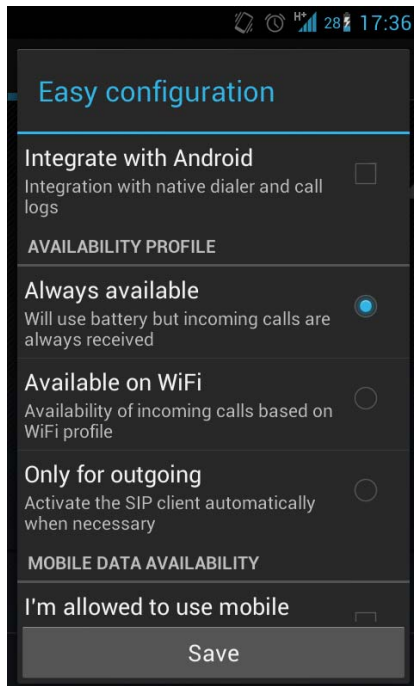
Steps for setting up Android SIP software

1. Search and download “CSipSimple” from Google PlayStore

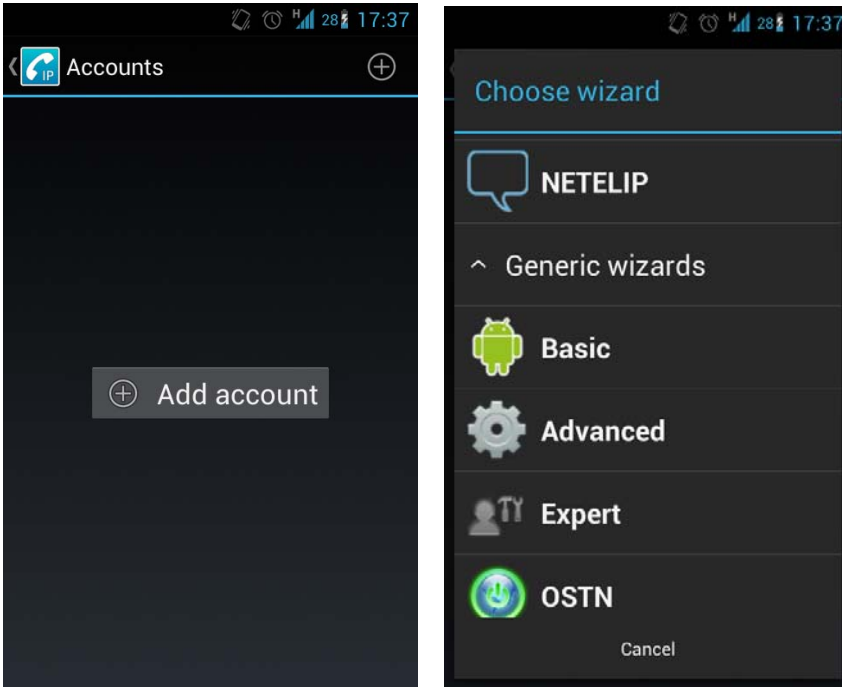


2. After the installation, open CSipSimple app, change the settings according to following:

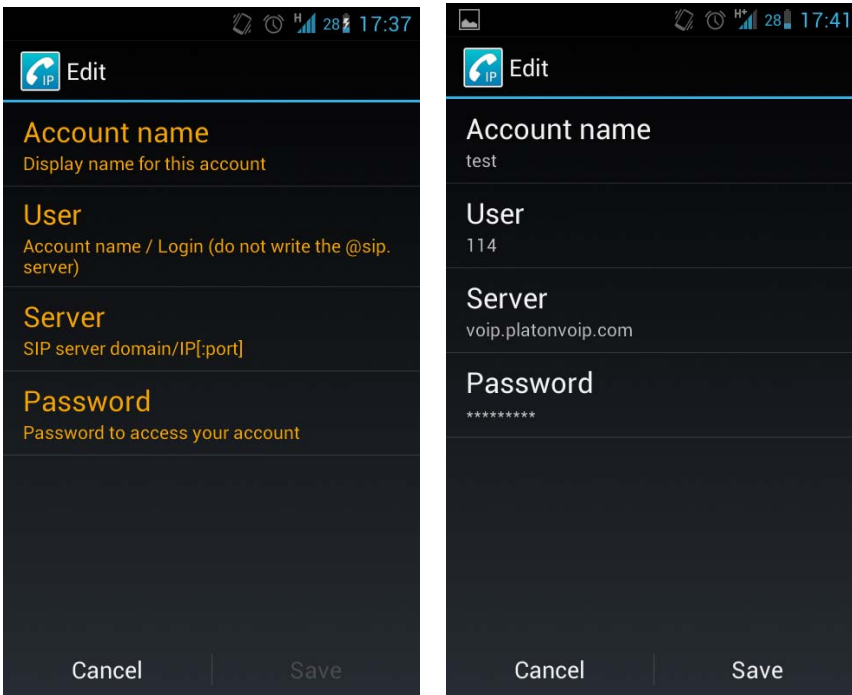
- Integrate with Android: Disable
- In “AVAILABILITY PROFILE”: Choose “Always available”
- Option “I’m allowed to use mobile”: Enable



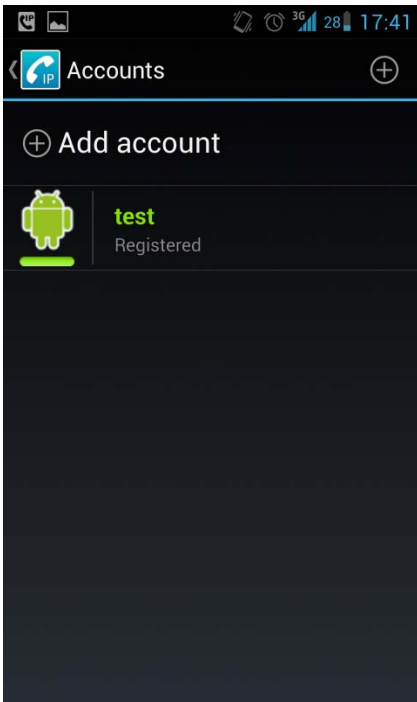
3. Press "Add Account" and choose "Basic"



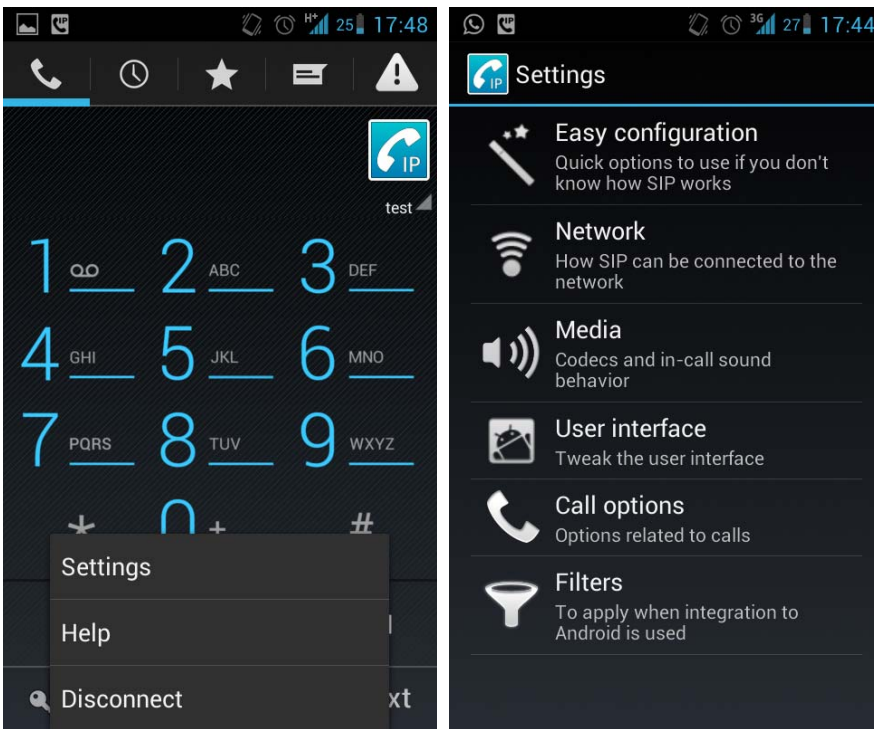
4. Input the user account information and server address, press "Save" when complete
(Note: Account Name and Account ID will be the username given by your administrator)



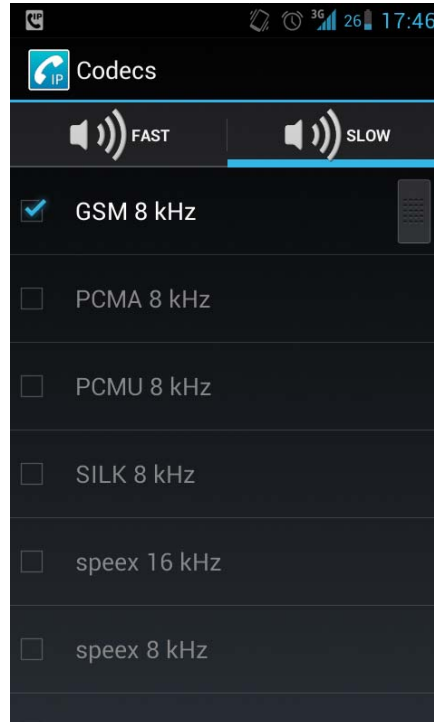
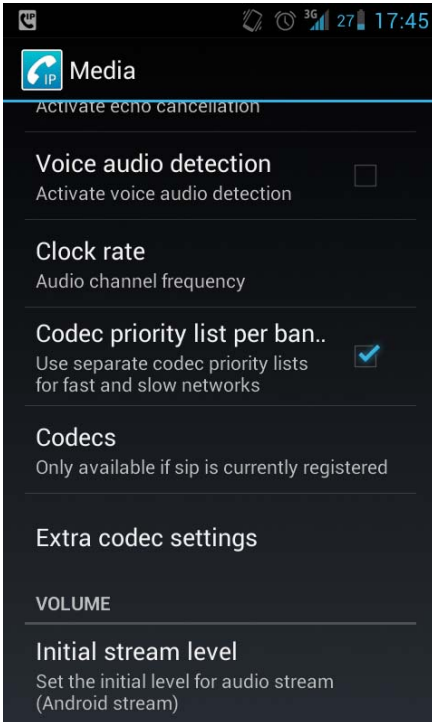
5. If setup is correct, the word “Registered” should be shown under the account title.



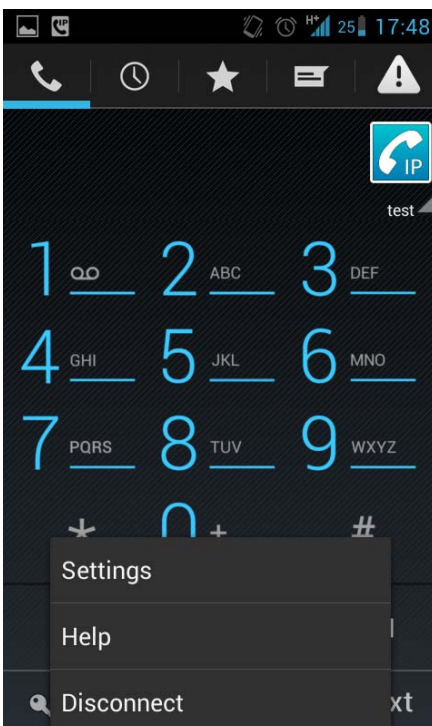
6. Press “Back” button of your Android device, then press “Menu” button of your Android device when dialer page is shown, pres “Settings”



7. Press “Media” and press “Codecs”, enabled “GSM 8 kHz” in both “FAST” and “SLOW” menu



8. The CSipSimple app will run as background even you’ve changed to another application within Android, which will have Internet traffic occasionally to keep the account connected. To shutdown the app, go back to CSipSimple main screen, press “Menu” key of the Android device and press “Disconnect”.
